### Local & State News

- ◆ **VEC PLANS POWER OUTAGE FOR RICEVILLE**  
Volunteer Energy Cooperative customers in the Riceville area of McMinn County will experience a power outage from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. this Saturday, October 20th. The outage is required to allow crews to safely energize VEC's new Riceville Substation.
- ◆ **AUB EXPLAINS STRANGE NEWSLETTER IN BILL**  
Some AUB customers will get a newsletter in their next bill that shares some good information about Athens Utilities programs, practices, and news. The newsletter is from the municipal utility in Athens, Alabama. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough said that both utilities have a common billing contractor, Arista Information Services, and they accidentally stuffed newsletters intended for Athens, Alabama, into Athens, Tennessee, utilities bills.
- ◆ **COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE**  
✓ The E.G. Fisher Public Library will host a noon book discussion today. Mike Nichols will lead the discussion on *That Used to be Us: How America Fell Behind in the World it Created and How We Can Come Back* by Thomas Friedman and Michael Mandelbaum. The Noon Book discussion is sponsored by Friends of the Library. A light lunch will be provided and all are welcome to attend.


### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The White House has put special operation strike forces on standby. Drones have been moved into the skies above Africa, ready to strike militant targets from Libya to Mali, if investigators can find the al-Qaida-linked group responsible for the death of the U.S. ambassador and three other Americans in Libya.
- ◆ General Electric Co, Alcoa Inc, Boeing Co and Lockheed-Martin Corp unveiled plans for a new group committed to train military veterans to work in the manufacturing sector. The four largest U.S. manufacturers agreed to provide financial support for the "Get Skills to Work Coalition" and will aim to train 15,000 veterans, who will be hired by the four companies or matched to other jobs. Open jobs will be listed on LinkedIn.
- ◆ Sen. Joe Lieberman's committee will try to 'find out what happened and why' in the Benghazi attack, but panel staff say the information-gathering stage is unlikely to be finished by election time.
- ◆ Two more drugs from a specialty pharmacy linked to a meningitis outbreak are now being investigated. U.S. health officials are urging doctors to contact patients who got any kind of injection from the company to be aware of possible infections.
- ◆ CNN's Candy Crowley is the moderator for tonight's second presidential debate from Hofstra University on Long Island at 9pm.


