◆ RAILS TO TRAILS RALLY THIS EVENING

Supporters of a proposal to build a recreational trail from Athens to Englewood over a former CSX Railroad rail bed will be holding an informational rally this evening at Knox Park on Slack Road. The rally begins at 6:30 p.m. and will be held at the pavillion area of Knox Park, which would be the trailhead of the proposed project. Organizers of the rally say they want to present factual information about the project's cost and potential benefits.

World & National News

- ◆ In the aftermath of Mitt Romney's debates with President Obama, he continues to claim momentum insisting that the forums boosted his campaign but "diminished" his Democratic opponent's. Romney told a crowd of roughly 2,500 people in Reno, Nevada that the President had now been reduced to talking about 'Sesame Street' characters and word games and misplaced attacks on me.
- ◆ Donald Trump announced on Wednesday that he would give \$5 million to a charity of President Obama's choice in exchange for the release of the commander in chief's college records and passport application. The offer is on the table until October 31st.
- ◆ One day after the Emir of Qatar made a rare visit to the enclave's Hamas leadership, Palestinians fired dozens of rockets into Israel from Gaza on Wednesday and a militant was killed by an Israeli air strike. Hamas claimed responsibility for some of the rocket and mortar bomb attacks.
- ◆ April Pettit, an infectious disease specialist at Vanderbilt University, ordered "extra tests" on the spinal fluid of a patient and is credited by colleagues with unlocking the mystery of a devastating fungal meningitis outbreak and prompting a national alert that may have saved many lives.

1825 - Austrian composer Johann Strauss, Junior, was born. He was called the "Waltz King." His best-known work is "The Blue Danube Waltz."

1854 - In what is known as the "Charge of the Light Brigade," 670 British cavalrymen fighting in the Crimean War attacked a heavily fortified Russian position. The British were wiped out.

1881 - Artist Pablo Picasso was born in Malaga, Spain.

1912 - The late Minnie Pearl, Grand Ole Opry star, was born. Her first words may have been, "Howdy, I'm just so proud to be here."

1971 - The U.N. General Assembly voted to admit mainland Communist China and expel free China, Taiwan.

1983 - A U.S.-led force invaded Grenada at the order of President Reagan which was needed to protect U.S. citizens.

2001 - Microsoft released the Windows XP operating system.

2003 - Florida State's Bobby Bowden became the winningest coach in major college football history with his 339th victory as the Seminoles beat Wake Forest 48-24.

Wednesday Market Closings

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 25.19 at 13,077.34. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 4.36 at 1,408.75. The NASDAQ Composite Index was down 8.77 at 2,981.70. In commodity markets, the spot price of gold fell \$5.60 to \$1,702.05, the spot price of silver rose \$0.06 to \$31.75, and crude oil prices fell \$0.97 to \$85.70 per barrel. In the bond market, the 30-year Treasury yield closed at 2.95%, and the 10-year Treasury yield finished at 1.79%.
