◆ PROJECT WIPEOUT 2 TARGETS CRIME

On Thursday, 4 teams of officers with the McMinn County Sheriff's Office were out in force as they participated in a county-wide crime suppression event called "Wipeout 2". The operation resulted in several arrests and the seizure of a meth lab and marijuana plants. Officers attended an 8 A.M. briefing session at the Justice Center that outlined the plan and guidelines of the operation. "Crime Suppression Teams" were given assignments of locations and names of suspects to locate, and points such as professionalism and legal issues were addressed. NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Touch-screen electronic voting machines in four key battleground states, Pennsylvania, Virginia, Florida, and Colorado pose a risk to the integrity of the 2012 presidential election, according to a Monitor analysis. They could produce incorrect or incomplete tallies that would be difficult to detect and all but impossible to correct because the machines have no paper record for officials to go back and check.

◆ Forecasters have upped the odds of a major weather mess, known as "Frankenstorm" to a 90 percent chance that the East will get steady gale-force winds, heavy rain, flooding and maybe snow starting Sunday and stretching past Halloween on Wednesday. The worst of the weather mayhem will be around New York City and New Jersey. "Frankenstorm" is an unusual nasty mix of a hurricane and a winter storm. Meteorologists say it is likely to cause \$1 billion in damage.

◆ On Thursday, Gilberto Valle, a New York City police officer was charged with leading a ghoulish double life by using a law enforcement database and fetish chat rooms to dream up a plot to torture women and then cook and eat their body parts. The officer was arrested by the FBI after his estranged wife had alerted New York authorities to his chilling online activity.
