◆ DUMP TRUCK FLIPS, DRIVER INJURED

Tellico Street in Englewood (SR39E) was blocked for several hours Monday when a Mack dump truck driven by Augustin Gutiérrez of Decatur wrecked. - ◆ It's election day and the race between President Obama and Mitt Romney is the closest in 76 years according to a review of polling data going back to 1936. Polling isn't an exact science, and few polls take into account electoral votes, which ultimately decide the winner of the presidential race.
- ◆ A key issue that has emerged in the presidential campaign is the decline of the middle class, and both candidates are promising policies to restore the economic stability of the middle class. Wages for the middle class, particularly men, has stagnated over the past 40 years. A lot of men are no longer in the workforce or are even working part time.
- ◆ When Christine Treglia, returned to her home after "Superstorm Sandy", she was surprised to find a note from a Toms River, N.J., man. The man identified only as Mike, didn't think he would survive Sandy's storm surge, broke into Treglia's house and wrote a note to his dad that said, "tell my Dad I love him." Thankfully the man was reunited with his father, and both will have a lifetime to retell his tale of survival.
- ◆ Government leaders are trying to cope with the next crisis of Superstorm Sandy: finding housing for potentially tens of thousands of people left homeless.

✓ U.S. stocks closed slightly higher as investors await the outcome of the Presidential election today. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 19.28 at 13,112.44. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 3.06 at 1,417.26. The NASDAQ Composite Index was up 17.53 at 2,999.66. In commodity markets, the spot price of gold rose \$5.60 to \$1,683.70, the spot price of silver rose \$0.26 to \$31.17, and crude oil prices rose \$0.96 to \$85.82. In the bond market, the 30-year Treasury yield closed at 2.87%, and the 10-year Treasury yield finished at 1.68%.
