Local & State News

◆ TUESDAY'S ELECTION RESULTS

Athens City Voters decided to re-elect Ann Scott Davis (1845) to the Athens City Council yesterday while newcomer and a TEA Party favorite, Chuck Burris (2284), won the top spot in balloting to pick-up the only open seat on the Athens City Council. In the Athens City School Board race, the top vote getter was Chris Adams (3438). In second place was Mike Bevins (2928) and in third was newcomer Alf Hacker with (2465). Charlie Senn was in fourth (2142). The top three were the winners. The City of Etowah held two liquor referendums. The "For" votes for Liquor by the Drink was 598 while those "Against" was 496. The "For" votes for retail package stores was 629 while the "Against" vote was 464. In the Niota City election, 3 seats were open and 4 candidates ran. The winners were: William Andrews (145), Allen Watkins (138), and Tabathia Gates (122). The City of Calhoun had 3 races for city commission and only 3 candidates, therefore Cindy Baker, James Duffy, and John Walker won by default. In the State House of Representatives, District 23, Incumbent John Forgety won with 75.8% of the vote (17,025) to Peggy Wall's 24.2% (5,422). In the U.S. Senate, Incumbent Bob Corker won with 69.5% to Mark Clayton's 25.9%.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ President Barack Obama won re-election Tuesday, defeating former Massachusetts Gov. Mitt Romney despite a weak economy that plagued his first term. In his victory statement, President Obama predicted better days ahead. With returns in from 88 percent of the nation's precincts, Obama had 49.8% of the popular vote and Romney had 48.6%. Democrats retained control of the Senate and Republicans remain in control of the House.
- ◆ On Election Day, the social media giant, Facebook, was watching how many people were posting about going to the polls. Facebook is keeping track of more than just the things you like and the games you play; women have outnumbered men nearly 2 to 1.
- ◆ Lawrence Jones, 42, a discharged parolee shot four coworkers before shooting himself at a workplace in Fresno, California. Three of the four people that were shot died including the gunman. Two other people remain hospitalized.
- ◆ A British businessman, Neil Heywood, murdered, about a year ago in China and involved in a high-profile case of political intrigue, was an informal source of information for Britain's foreign intelligence agency, MI6. British government officials claim that Heywood was not an employee of the British government.

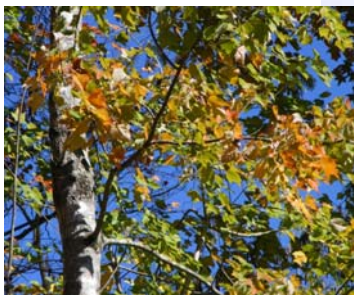
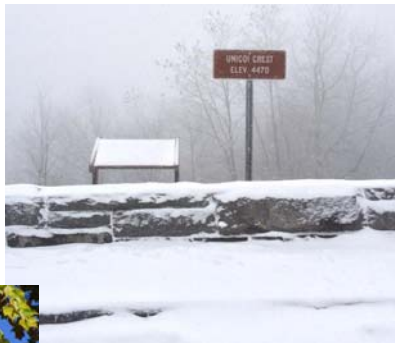

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 133.24 at 13,245.68. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 11.13 at 1,428.39. The NASDAQ Composite Index was up 12.27 at 3,011.93. Volume on the New York Stock Exchange was low today, with 638.24 million shares traded. Advancers outnumbered decliners by roughly a 3 - to - 1 margin. In commodity markets, the spot price of gold rose \$32.15 to \$1,717.15, the spot price of silver rose \$0.87 to \$32.05, and crude oil prices rose \$2.74 to \$88.39. In the bond market, the 30-year Treasury yield closed at 2.92%, and the 10-year Treasury yield finished at 1.75%.
