NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Two weeks after Superstorm Sandy, more than 70,000 customers of Long Island Power Authority, in New York, were without electricity Monday, however nearly 1.1 million customers had restored power by Monday morning.
- ◆ Last week's election results were largely as expected. The President won re-election, Democrats still have a majority in the Senate, and Republicans control the House of Representatives. The only surprise was the brutally negative reaction of Wall Street. The President's victory can be used as evidence by democrats that the public is backing his "tax the rich" posturing, but exit polling data by the republicans, show 63% of the public oppose new taxes.
- ◆ According to a Western energy agency, the United States will overtake Saudi Arabia and Russia as the world's top oil producer by 2017. Washington will come very close to achieving a previously unthinkable energy self-sufficiency. Upstream technologies are unlocking light crude oil and shale gas resources, and the recent rebound in U.S. oil and gas production, is spurring economic activity - with less expensive gas and electricity prices giving American industry a competitive edge on the world market.

Monday's Market Closings

U.S. stocks closed flat on Monday amid uncertainty of whether politicians would reach an agreement and avoid automatic tax hikes and spending cuts that would begin in January. Also, another report out of China revealed the country's exports rose to a five-month high in October, signaling a possible end to several consecutive quarters of slowing economic growth. The U.S. Treasury market was closed in observance for the Veteran's Day holiday. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 0.23 at 12,815.16. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 0.15 at 1,380.00. The NASDAQ Composite Index was down 0.62 at 2,904.26. In commodity markets, the spot price of gold fell \$3.08 to \$1,728.10, the spot price of silver fell \$0.19 to \$32.4, and crude oil prices fell \$0.45 to \$85.62 per barrel.
