#### ◆ OCCUPANTS OF CAR RESCUED FROM CREEK

Two people are safe, thanks to quick work by Athens Police Sergeant Tony Byers and two members of the Athens Fire Department. Two cars collided at South White Street and Green Street early Monday morning when one car pulled out in front of the other. The first car then spun around and rolled backwards, landing on its top in the creek. When Sergeant Byers arrived on the scene, he discovered the two occupants were still inside the car. He waded into the creek and with the help of a fireman pulled the passenger, Gary Rose, from a back window. Two firemen then pried open a door and rescued the driver, Amy Young of Athens. Both were treated at Athens Regional Medical Center for minor injuries. The driver of the other vehicle, Lee Wilkins of Englewood, was not injured. Traffic on South White Street was blocked for about an hour.
