State & Local News

◆ MEIGS CO. SHOOTING UPDATE

A man who was convicted of killing his 14-month-old daughter in 2003 is back in the news, this time as a shooting victim. Mitchell Delashmitt is listed in stable condition at Erlanger Hospital after being shot Tuesday afternoon at a house in the Cottonport Community in Meigs County. Delashmitt had gone to the home of Wendall Beaty. The two men got into an altercation and Delashmitt was shot. At this point, no charges have been filed.

Delashmitt made news when his daughter, Angel, was found dead in a pond at his home in McMinn County. He claimed he was babysitting her and said she wandered away when he fell asleep. He later made a confession. After a series of hearings and court rulings which said his confession was coerced, Delashmitt pleaded guilty to reckless homicide and child neglect. He served five years in prison.

◆ SMALL EARTHQUAKE HITS THE AREA

Another small earthquake struck the area early Thursday morning. The 2.0 magnitude quake was recorded at 6:09 a.m. and was centered 13 miles east of Etowah. A caller said her porch ladder shook.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ There was an explosion yesterday at a Bartow County, GA, power plant outside Cartersville. Georgia Power stated that Plant Bowen coal unit 2 was being shut-down for maintenance when the explosion occurred. No one was seriously injured and there was only one minor injury. The explosion occurred around 4:30 p.m.

◆ The Senate is expected to begin debating a bill to vastly expand the federal background check system for gun buyers. The proposed legislation, would close the so-called gun show loophole which allows a substantial number of gun sales to take place without background checks. If Congress passes the bill, proponents say fewer domestic abusers, felons and mentally ill people will be able to buy weapons, but The National Rifle Association says expanding the checks won't stop crime, because most criminals get their guns on the black market.

◆ For years, supporters of marijuana legalization have pointed to polls trending their way, claiming the issue was about to tip as favorable to a majority of Americans. For the first time, a major U.S. poll shows a majority of nationwide support for legalizing marijuana: 52 percent now back legalized pot, compared with 45 percent who oppose it, according to a new survey from the Pew Research Center.

◆ After a long battle with cancer, renowned film critic Roger Ebert has died at the age of 70. Ebert died two days after he announced a "leave of presence" due to his health. He was an opinionated writer, but was perhaps best known for his 31 years reviewing films on television.

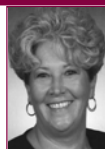
