### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A strong spring storm system that's brought everything from tornadoes to ice and snow to much of the Midwest and parts of the southeast United States is being blamed for two deaths. In Mississippi, one person died and several people were injured after a reported tornado struck Kemper County in the far eastern part of the state. In the Nebraska Panhandle, a woman died Tuesday while trying to trudge through a blinding snowstorm from her disabled car to her house which was just a mile away.
- ◆ A Cardinal Coach Lines bus carrying about 45 people, mostly senior citizens, careened off a North Texas highway and flipped onto its side where at least two people were killed and more than 40 were hospitalized. The chartered bus was on its way to a casino in Oklahoma.
- ◆ Senate Minority Leader Mitch McConnell's campaign deplored reports that liberal activist group Progress Kentucky was behind an audiotape published Tuesday about a private meeting between McConnell and top advisers. Reports claim that left-wing activists illegally recorded a private meeting inside McConnell's campaign headquarters. The Progress Kentucky founders claim they taped while standing in the hallway outside the meeting room. The FBI is investigating.
