World & National News

- ◆ As thousands gathered at a campus memorial, Sean Collier, the slain Massachusetts Institute of Technology police officer, was remembered Wednesday for his dedication to law enforcement and his love of people. On April 18, Collier was fatally shot three days after the Boston Marathon bombings that killed three people. He was shot by brothers Tamerlan and Dzhokhar Tsarnaev while sitting in his police car, according to authorities.
- ◆ In west-central Illinois, five people were found shot to death Wednesday at a house. In a police chase and exchange of gunfire, a suspect was fatally wounded. Authorities did not provide any information on the victims. The relationship of the suspect to the victims is unknown at this time.
- ◆ Another Mississippi man is being investigated in connection with ricin-laced letters sent to the president and a Mississippi U.S. senator. Everett Dutschke said investigators searched his house after charges were dropped against Paul Kevin Curtis. On Wednesday, investigators searched a small retail space where Dutschke used to operate a martial arts studio. They wore hazardous materials suits and were seen going in and out of the building. No charges have been filed and Dutschke has not been arrested.

Wednesday's Market Report

U.S. stocks wavered between gains and losses and ended mixed. Investors digested corporate earnings results from Proctor & Gamble and Apple which exceeded expectations but provided outlook guidance that was below the consensus views. Adding to the downside, durable goods orders fell 5.7% in March, logging their steepest drop in seven months. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 43.16 at 14,676.30. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 0.01 at 1,578.79, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 0.32 at 3,269.65.

Today In History - April 25

- 1874** - Guglielmo Marconi, the inventor of the wireless telegraph (or radio), was born in Italy. He produced the first trans-Atlantic wireless telegraph signal. His work led to modern radio broadcasting.
- 1908** - Radio and television journalist Edward R. Murrow was born. He broadcast on-the-scene reports of World War II bombings in London and his listeners could hear the bombs exploding in the background. His broadcasts began with the words, "This is London..."
- 1918** - Singer Ella Fitzgerald was born. Her hit records included "A Tisket A-Tasket" and "It's Only A Paper Moon."
- 1945** - Delegates from some 50 countries met in San Francisco to organize the United Nations.
- 1990** - The Hubble Space Telescope was deployed from the space shuttle Discovery.
- 2007** - The Dow Jones industrial average topped 13,000 for the first time, ending the day at 13,089.89.
