◆ TWO NEW SUPERMARKETS ON THE WAY

Two new supermarkets will be opening soon in Athens. One is the IGA Price Less store which will be opening in the former Food Lion location on Decatur Pike. Items will be priced based on the cost of getting them to the shelf. Customers will pay a flat 10% on top of those prices.

The other supermarket is PickUpMyGroceries.com. This is a new concept where customers shop online and then stop by the store and pick up their groceries. The new store will be located in the old Wal-Mart building next to Fowlers Furniture.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ U.S. Presidents and dignitaries from around the world gathered yesterday to dedicate the library and museum of President George W. Bush. President Obama said Bush was a good man who showed strong leadership in the days after the nation was attacked by terrorists on Sept. 11, 2001. Obama praised Bush for his incredible strength and resolve as he stood amid the rubble and the ruins of Ground Zero and promised to deliver justice to those who had sought to destroy our way of life.

◆ Dzhokhar Tsarnaev and Tamerlan Tsarnaev, the suspects in last week's deadly Boston Marathon bombing decided, after authorities identified them, to drive to New York and set off additional explosives in New York City's Times Square. Their plan unraveled when they realized that the vehicle they had hijacked did not have enough gasoline for the journey. Police learned of this plan while questioning Dzhokhar in a Boston hospital. His brother Tamerlan died after the bombings, in a shootout with police.

◆ In Bangladesh, at least 260 people, mainly female workers, were killed and more than 1,000 were injured when an eight-story factory building collapsed on Wednesday. Many of the world's clothes are produced in Bangladeshi factories. There are around 4500 factories that employ 4 million workers and generate 80 percent of Bangladesh's \$24 billion annual exports.
