### ◆ TIPS FOR CONTROLLING "SKEETERS"

Now that warm weather is here, the Athens Public Works Department has some tips for controlling mosquitoes. Homeowners should walk around their property and look for buckets, tin cans, old tires, unused swimming pools or other containers that collect and hold water. Do not allow water to accumulate in any container for more than two days. You should also clean debris out of rain gutters and change water in birdbaths and wading pools at least once a week. Put up birdhouses to attract birds which dine on mosquitoes.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A jury has found abortionist Kermit Gosnell guilty of three counts of first-degree murder after deliberating for 10 days on the case. Prosecutors are expected to now seek the death penalty for Gosnell. The 72-year-old was charged with killing four premature babies by severing their spinal cords after they were born alive in his Philadelphia clinic. He was acquitted of one of those charges and convicted in three. Gosnell was also found guilty in the accidental death of a patient who died after receiving an abortion and a lethal mix of sedatives and painkillers at his clinic.
- ◆ President Obama has furiously dismissed as a "political circus" Republican charges that his administration had misled the public about the Sept. 12, 2012, attack on the U.S. compound in Benghazi, Libya. Obama said the accusations of a cover-up dishonor the memory of the four Americans killed in the onslaught.
- ◆ The Ohio attorney general says the man accused of imprisoning three women in a Cleveland house for about a decade isn't linked to other crimes through a national database.
- ◆ Popular psychologist, columnist, and television and film personality Dr. Joyce Brothers has died. She was 85.
- ◆ 2012 was the worst year for West Nile Virus deaths. The final tally was 286, two more than the record set in 2002.
