## Local & State News

### ◆ AUB SAYS JUNE POWER RATES TO GO UP

The price for electricity for AUB customers in June will rise slightly compared to the May rate as the result of higher generation costs from TVA and because June begins the summer rate schedule with higher base rates. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says the average residential customer will see a \$5.49 increase in their monthly bill in June.

### ◆ PARKS DEPARTMENT TO HOLD OPEN FORUM

The Athens Parks and Recreation Department will host an open forum tomorrow night, May 16th, at 6 p.m. at City Hall. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss the interest in adult and family athletic opportunities for the upcoming fall and the new year. Multiple sports for all ages will be discussed, including adult softball, kickball leagues, volleyball leagues, wiffle ball, youth and adult flag football, etc.

### ◆ RECEPTION PLANNED FOR M.E.D.A. HEAD

The Athens and Etowah Chambers of Commerce will host a welcoming reception for Kathy Knight, the new Executive Director of the McMinn Economic Development Authority, next Tuesday from 4p.m. to 5 p.m. at the McMinn County Airport Terminal.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ The Justice Department is opening a criminal investigation into the targeting of Tea Party groups by the I.R.S. for extra scrutiny over whether they qualified for tax exempt status. Attorney General Eric Holder said the FBI is coordinating with the Department of Justice to see if any laws were broken.

◆ The National Transportation Safety Board voted on Tuesday to recommend a lower blood alcohol limit for drivers, from .08% to .05%, advancing its campaign to cut down on drinking-related road deaths through a stricter definition of impairment.

◆ Republican National Committee Chairman Reince Priebus has asked President Obama to fire Attorney General Eric Holder. Priebus argued that the Justice Department had violated the First Amendment by scooping up phone records of Associated Press reporters and editors, a clear violation of the constitution.

◆ Kermit Gosnell, the abortionist convicted of multiple counts of murder, cut a deal to serve two life sentences and waive his right to an appeal, thus avoiding the death penalty.

◆ Gov. Mark Dayton has signed a bill making gay marriage legal in Minnesota, the 12th state to take the step, as thousands of on-lookers cheered.
