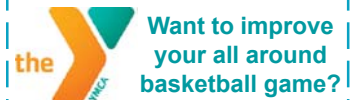

Local & State News

◆ ETOWAH FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

It has been a busy time for the City of Etowah Fire Department. As of July 23, the Etowah Fire Department had responded to 309 incidents. First Responder calls totaled 232. There were 10 structure fires, three vehicle fires, eight vehicle accidents, nine calls involving hazardous materials, and 28 false alarms. Other calls included assisting police, setting up helicopter landing zones, brush fires, and animal rescues.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Army Pfc. Bradley Manning was acquitted of aiding the enemy for sharing classified documents on U.S. military actions in Iraq and Afghanistan with WikiLeaks, but was convicted of lesser charges, including espionage. Military Judge Col. Denise Lind issued her verdict early Tuesday afternoon and found Manning guilty of five espionage counts, five theft charges, a computer fraud charge and other military infractions.

◆ The driver of the train that derailed near Santiago de Compostela, Spain, was on the phone with a colleague and apparently looking at a document as his train barreled ahead at 95 mph, almost twice the speed limit. The train hurtled off the tracks and slammed into a concrete wall, killing 79 people.

◆ The Obama administration's surprise decision to delay a key requirement of the health care law for employers will cost the government \$10 billion according to the Congressional Budget Office. The delay of the health law requirement for employers with 50 or more workers to offer affordable coverage, or face fines, will go into effect in 2015, after the 2014 mid-term elections.

◆ The man who was abandoned in a Drug Enforcement Administration holding cell for four days without food or water has agreed to settle claims for \$4.1 million.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks were mixed with data that showed home prices in May turned in their best annual gains in more than seven years. However, limiting any upward momentum was a report that showed confidence among U.S. consumers declined in July from a five-year high as increasing borrowing costs and gasoline prices softened Americans' outlook for the economy. U.S. Treasury prices are trending higher as the Fed began its two-day meeting. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 1.38 at 15,520.59. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 0.63 at 1,685.96, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 17.33 at 3,616.47.

In commodity markets: The spot price of gold fell \$1.96 to \$1326.06. The spot price of silver fell \$0.13 to \$19.74, and crude oil prices fell \$1.39 to \$103.16 per barrel.
