◆ TWO HURT IN COUNTY ROAD 756 WRECK

◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:

- ✓ Volunteer Energy Cooperative warns that someone claiming to be a representative of VEC has been telephoning customers trying to get money for "delinquent" electric bills. The caller asks for a bank account number and a social security number and asks the customer to purchase a pre-paid credit card and pay the bill with that card. The caller claims that if payment is not received, the customer's power will be shut off within the hour. VEC says it's a scam and you should alert them if you receive a similar call.
- ✓ There will be a Spaghetti Dinner from 5 to 7 p.m. today at the VFW Post on N. Congress Parkway. The cost is \$6.00 per plate. The event is open to the public.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Hosni Mubarak, Egypt's former leader, could soon be freed from jail, after a court ruled on Monday that he could no longer be held in custody on a corruption charge. Mubarak, who is 85, may have no political future, but his release could stir emotions and raise new questions on whether the popular uprising that ended his 30-year rule is going back to a new form or type of military-backed government.
- ◆ In one of the biggest waves of refugees since the rebellion against President Bashar Assad began, tens of thousands of Syrian Kurds have swarmed across a bridge into neighboring Iraq's northern self-ruled Kurdish region over the past few days.
- ◆ San Diego Mayor Bob Filner was nowhere to be found when City Hall opened yesterday. Filner still remains out of public view as he tries to survive a recall effort prompted by a cascade of sexual harassment allegations. The entire City Council and many leading fellow Democrats have asked Filner to resign.
- ◆ As part of a push to increase high-level contacts between senior U.S. and Chinese defense leaders, Defense Secretary Chuck Hagel says he will visit China next year.
- ◆ The lawyer representing Alex Rodriguez says that Major League Baseball's evidence against Rodriguez is so weak he shouldn't serve even one inning of his 211-game suspension. Rodriguez was recently suspended by the league, along with more than a dozen other players, for their relationship with a clinic accused of distributing performance-enhancing drugs.

1833 - Our 23rd President, Benjamin Harrison, was born in Ohio.

1923 - Singer Jim Reeves was born. Among his hits, "He'll Have To Go," "Four Walls," and "An Old Christmas Card." Reeves was killed when his private plane crashed near Nashville in 1964.

1940 - British Prime Minister Winston Churchill paid tribute to the Royal Air Force, saying, "Never in the field of human conflict was so much owed by so many to so few."

1953 - The Soviet Union publicly acknowledged it had tested a hydrogen bomb.

1974 - Sheriff Buford Pusser of McNairy County, TN, was killed in a car wreck. Sheriff Pusser won fame in the 1970's by fighting corruption along the Tennessee-Mississippi border. The movie "Walking Tall" was based on his fight for law and order.

2009 - The only man convicted of the bombing of Pan Am Flight 103 returned home to Libya after his release from a Scottish prison on compassionate grounds.
