NATIONAL & INTERNATIONAL NEWS

◆ An American, who is one of Somalia's most visible Islamic rebels and one of the FBI's Most Wanted Terrorist, was reported to have been killed by rivals in the extremist group al-Shabab. It is believed that Omar Hammami was killed in an ambush in southern Somalia following months on the run, after falling out with al-Shabab's top leader.

◆ Heavy rains and scarring from recent wildfires sent walls of water crashing down mountainsides in Colorado on Thursday, cutting off mountain towns and forcing the University of Colorado to cancel classes. At least three people are dead. The flooding forced people from their homes and caused mud and rockslides in some areas.

◆ The United Nations has received a letter from Syria stating its intention to join the chemical weapons treaty which bans the production, stockpiling and use of the deadly weapons.

◆ According to a recent survey, one in five American adults are still struggling to buy enough food. Twenty percent of U.S. adults polled last month said that at times in the past year they had not had enough money to buy food for themselves or their family.
