LOCAL & AREA NEWS

◆ NO TAX INCREASE FOR NIOTA

Despite significantly higher liability insurance premiums, property taxes in Niota will not be increased. Niota city officials and the Municipal Technical Advisory Service were able to make the budget balance without raising taxes. The Niota City Commission has approved the budget on its first reading. However, sanitation fees may have to be raised.

◆ AUGUST JOBLESS RATE DROPS IN AREA

Unemployment in McMinn, Meigs and Monroe counties dropped in August. In McMinn County, the unemployment rate in August was 9.2%, down from 9.4% in July. The jobless rate in Meigs County was 9.6% in August, down from 10.2% in July. In Monroe County, the unemployment rate dropped a full percentage point, falling from 11.5% in July to 10.5% in August. In Bradley County, the jobless rate was 7.9% in August, down from 8.1% in July.

◆ GOVERNOR TO VISIT ATHENS TODAY

Governor Bill Haslam will be in Athens today to announce \$500,000 Community Development Block grants for sewer system upgrades in Athens and Etowah. The governor will make the announcement at 11:30 a.m. in the Blue Room of the McMinn County Courthouse.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks closed slightly higher, ending a five-day slump for the S&P, as positive economic reports overshadowed debt-ceiling budget talks. In other economic news, a Labor Department report showed that the number of Americans who filed applications for unemployment benefits fell last week. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 55.04 at 15,328.30. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 5.90 at 1,698.67, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 26.33 at 3,787.43.
