### LOCAL & AREA NEWS

#### ◆ WATCH OUT FOR RUDOLPH & BAMBI

The Tennessee Highway Patrol is warning motorists about deer-related traffic crashes during the fall and winter months. Col. Tracy Trott urges drivers to be especially aware and cautious in areas where deer are found. He says the chances of hitting a deer are considerably higher during the hunting and mating season, especially in November. Three people were killed in crashes involving deer in Tennessee last year. There were 5,911 deer-related crashes in the state last year.

Counties along Interstate 75 have the highest number of deer crashes. So far this year, there have been 40 collisions between vehicles and deer in McMinn County, 50 in Bradley County, 44 in Loudon County, and 10 in Monroe County. Meigs County, which does not have an interstate highway, has reported only 8 deer-related crashes this year.

Deer tend to move at dawn and dusk during mating season. The THP says motorists should not swerve to avoid hitting a deer, because that could cause your vehicle to flip or veer into oncoming traffic, causing an even more serious crash.

### NATIONAL AND WORLD NEWS

◆ Top House Republicans returned to Capitol Hill Thursday after meeting with President Obama in the White House to discuss a short-term debt ceiling increase. Both sides said more time would be needed for negotiations.

◆ Scott Carpenter, The United States' fourth astronaut to fly in space and the second to orbit the Earth, died on Thursday, Oct. 10th after suffering a recent stroke. Carpenter made his first and only spaceflight on May 24, 1962, when he became the sixth man worldwide to leave the planet. He was 88.

◆ The United States decision to withhold millions of dollars in mostly military aid to Egypt is fueling anti-U.S. sentiment and the perception that Washington supports Mohammed Morsi, the Islamist president who was ousted by the military in a July coup.

◆ Kwame Kilpatrick, a former Detroit mayor, was sent to federal prison for nearly three decades Thursday. Kilpatrick offered little remorse for the widespread corruption under his watch but acknowledged he let down the troubled city during a critical period before it landed in bankruptcy. Kilpatrick spent \$840,000 beyond his salary during his time as mayor, from 2002 to fall 2008.

◆ Former U.S. spy agency contractor Edward Snowden's father has arrived in Moscow to see his son. Snowden was granted asylum in Russia after leaking details of U.S. government surveillance programs.
