### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A Connecticut judge has ordered the release of the 911 tapes of calls from Sandy Hook Elementary School made during the December 14, 2012 shooting spree that killed 20 children and six adults. The audio recordings must be released by December 4th, a date chosen to give the state time to appeal the decision.
- ◆ The United States has asked Iran for help in finding American private investigator, Robert Levinson, who has been missing there for more than six years. Levinson disappeared during a business trip to an Iranian island in the Persian Gulf in March 2007.
- ◆ A tiny book of psalms from 1640, believed to be the first book printed in what's now the United States, sold for just under \$14.2 million on Tuesday, setting an auction record for a printed book.
- ◆ The Supreme Court has agreed to referee another dispute over President Obama's health care law. It will decide whether businesses can use religious objections to escape a requirement to cover birth control for employees.
- ◆ A sloppy storm system is slogging its way eastward carrying heavy rainfall, ice and snow, bringing the potential of headaches for travelers heading home for the Thanksgiving holiday, dumping lots of rain on parts of the Southeast.
