- ◆ **FIRE KILLS TWO IN MONROE COUNTY**
 A tragic house fire occurred in Monroe Co. Easter morning. Louise Turner, 86, and her son, 51-year-old William "Tank" Turner, died when their house caught fire on Short Bark Road. Three fire departments battled the blaze. The cause of the fire is under investigation.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The United Auto Workers union has withdrawn its objections filed with the National Labor Relations Board in February's vote at the Volkswagen plant in Chattanooga. VW employees rejected the union by a 712-626 vote. Monday's action by the UAW terminates the NLRB review process. The UAW says instead it will focus on a congressional investigation into an anti-unionization campaign by Republican politicians and outside groups. Senator Bob Corker says the UAW's objection was nothing more than a "sideshow" to draw attention away from their stinging loss in Chattanooga.
- ◆ Meb Keflezighi ended a 31-year drought for American men yesterday, when he won the Boston Marathon. Keflezighi, who was born in Eritrea, became an American citizen in 1998.

Is That What It Looks Like?

The Tennessee Historical Commission has announced six Tennessee sites have been added to the National Register of Historic Places. The most unusual site is the "Grand Guitar Building" which stands alongside I-81 in Bristol. The attention-catching building is shaped like a Martin Dreadnaught guitar and was built in 1983.
