#### ◆ GET READY TO "WET YOUR LINE"

The Athens Parks Department's 16th annual free Kids Fishing Derby will be held Saturday, May 3rd, from 8 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. at the Athens Regional Park. There will be more than \$1,500 in prizes, including a tagged trout worth \$500 sponsored by Happy and Laurie Powell. A free lunch will be provided to all participants starting at 10:30 a.m. The fishing derby is for boys and girls ages 12 and under. No fishing license is needed. All participants must register on site and be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Registration begins at 7 a.m.

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A government watchdog reports that the Internal Revenue Service has paid more than \$2.8 million in bonuses to employees with recent disciplinary problems, including \$1 million to workers who owed back taxes.
- ◆ JetBlue Airways Corp pilots voted by a wide margin on Tuesday to join the Air Line Pilots Association union, sending the bud-get carrier's stock price down on concerns the move would raise the airline's costs and lower their profitability.
- ◆ A gay rights group has filed a federal lawsuit in Atlanta chal-lenging the state of Georgia's constitutional ban on same-sex mar-riages. Tennessee has a similar ban in its constitution.

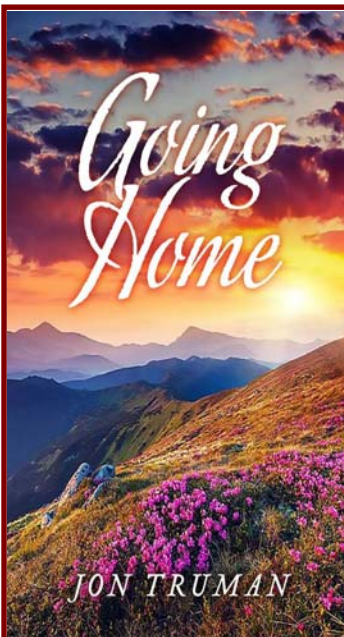
