### ◆ POLICE ARE HOT ON THE TRAIL

Athens police say they believe they know the identities of a white male and female driving a white Ford Explorer who are wanted in connection with the theft of a wallet from a car parked in the carport at a house on Tawanda Trail on April 16. The owner of the wallet told police that the wallet was stolen from her purse which she had left in her unlocked car. She said she believes her wallet was taken by a male and female who were going door to door in her neighborhood offering to trim trees. Her wallet contained cash and credit cards. The suspects used one of her credit cards to purchase gas at the Valley Mart on Decatur Pike that afternoon. They also forged her name to a withdrawal slip to get \$500 from her bank account. Surveillance video at the Valley Mart shows the suspects. Police expect to take out warrants against the pair shortly.

## National & International News

- ◆ A piece of sheet metal with rivets that washed ashore in south-western Australia is being examined to see if there is any link to the lost Air Malaysia plane.
- ◆ U.S. Army paratroopers arrived in Poland on Wednesday as part of a wave of U.S. troops heading to several countries near the Ukraine. The American troops will hold military exercises over the next month in a show of force designed to get the attention of Russian leaders.
- ◆ Georgia Gov. Nathan Deal has signed legislation that allows people with a permit to bring a gun into a bar without restriction. It also allows church leaders to decide whether it's OK for a person to bring a gun into a place of worship.
- ◆ Tennessee Governor Bill Haslam has signed a bill into law to ban the shredding of Imagination Library books that cannot be delivered because of wrong addresses. The bill directs the U.S. Postal Service to instead donate the books to pre-kindergarten or other programs. The Imagination Library was created by country singer Dolly Parton. The program provides a book every month to children from birth to age 5 at no cost to the family, regardless of income.
