◆ EARLY VOTING ENDS FOR AUGUST 7TH

Early voting for the August 7th County General and State Primary elections ended at noon this past Saturday. The McMinn County Election Commission office reported that 4,836 people voted early. Of those, 3,984 voted as Republicans, 764 voted as Democrats, and 88 people voted in the County General Election only.

◆ Israeli Prime Minister Netanyahu vows to use as much military power as needed and to fight "as long as it will take" against terrorist group Hamas to restore peace in his country.

◆ Dr. Ben Carson, a retired neurosurgeon and staunch conservative, is taking a couple of major steps toward a 2016 presidential bid. He's formed a political action committee and has named Texas businessman Terry Giles as his campaign chairman.

◆ The National Hurricane Center says Tropical Storm Bertha is likely to curve to the northeast and move parallel to the U.S. eastern seaboard without hitting the mainland. On Sunday, Bertha swirled over the Turks & Caicos Islands and the Bahamas.
