◆ ATHENS POLICE LOOKING FOR ROBBER

Athens police continue to look for a man who attempted to rob the Kangaroo on Decatur Pike Wednesday morning. They've identified the suspect as Alan Todd Grant. The clerk says Grant placed a pack of gum on the counter, pushed her out of the way, and grabbed \$30 from the cash drawer. He left behind plenty of evidence, including the pack of gum with his fingerprints, his wallet containing his ID and Social Security cards, and his image recorded on the store's surveillance cameras.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Arab nations have rallied behind President Obama's call to expand operations against ISIS terrorists in Iraq and Syria, as Damascus warned it would consider any action on its territory as an attack. Syria says any foreign intervention in their country would be an act of aggression unless it is approved by Damascus.

◆ Twenty people were kidnapped Thursday by ISIS terrorists in a northern Iraqi village suspected of forming a local group to fight them. The kidnappings were carried out in Kirkuk province by dozens of fighters from ISIS. ISIS kidnapped thousands of civilians last month as it overran minority-populated northern villages.

◆ There should be some answers soon as to how the NFL handled the Ray Rice situation. The NFL has hired former FBI director Robert S. Mueller III to investigate the league's handling of the domestic violence incident with Rice. Rice was cut by the Ravens on Monday. Two NFL owners, John Mara of the Giants and Art Rooney of the Steelers, will oversee the investigation.

◆ Microsoft Corp co-founder Paul Allen's charitable foundation is donating \$9 million to support U.S. efforts to fight the Ebola outbreak in West Africa. The gift will be made to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), which is headquartered in Atlanta.

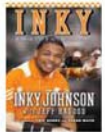

TODAY IN HISTORY - September 12th

- 1609** - British explorer Henry Hudson discovered the Hudson River. He was attempting to find a route around North America to the far east.
- 1818** - Richard Gatling was born in North Carolina. He invented the "Gatling" gun, which consisted of 10 barrels clustered around a revolving shaft. It was turned with a crank and could fire 350 rounds per minute.
- 1931** - Country singer George Jones was born. His hits include "She Thinks I Still Care" and "He Stopped Loving Her Today." Jones died in Nashville on April 26, 2013.
- 1944** - Singer Barry White was born in Galveston, Texas. One of his biggest hit records was "You're The First, The Last, My Everything." He died in 2005.
- 2008** - A commuter train engineer ran a red light while text messaging on his cell phone and struck a freight train head-on in Los Angeles, killing himself and 24 other people.
