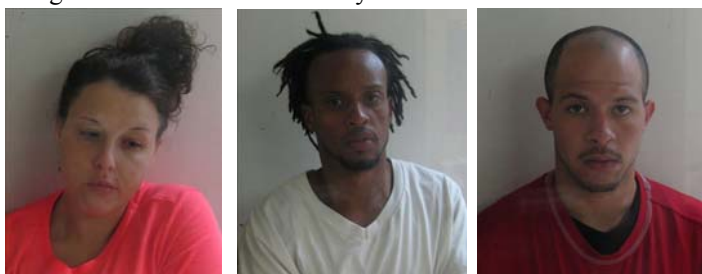

#### ◆ APD ARRESTS ROBBERY SUSPECTS

The three suspects identified in the armed robbery of a man at the Athens Mews Apartments on Tuesday night are now in custody. Police say that Stephanie Owen, 31, of Sweetwater, apparently lured the victim to her apartment, where two men robbed him at gun-point as soon as he walked through the door, taking his wallet and car keys. Owen was charged with aggravated robbery and fraudulent use of a debit/credit card. She is being held on \$21,000 bond. Her accomplices, identified as Rashied Wilkerson, age 33, and Kenneth "Chase" Barnett, 23, face similar charges and are also being held in the McMinn County Jail under bond.

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ The Liberian man infected with Ebola who brought the disease to the United States will be prosecuted when he returns home for lying on his airport screening questionnaire. Passengers leaving Liberia are being screened for fever and are asked if they have had contact with anyone infected.
- ◆ Retired Secret Service agent Joseph Clancy has been appointed acting interim director of the Secret Service by the Department of Homeland Security after the resignation of Julia Pierson, the embattled agency's first female director, over the series of recent security blunders that involved President Obama.
- ◆ The family of the Texas Ebola patient, Thomas Eric Duncan, have been ordered to stay in their home after violating officials' initial request not to leave. Duncan is being held at a Dallas area hospital in isolation after being diagnosed with Ebola. It was thought he had come in contact with about 18 people, now it's over 100.

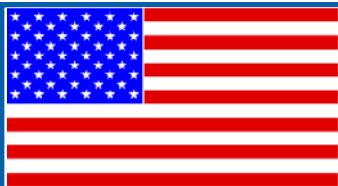
