◆ EARLY VOTING STARTS TOMORROW

Early voting for the November 4th election starts tomorrow and continues through October 30th. In McMinn County, you can vote early at the Election Commission Office at the Courthouse Annex. The hours are Monday-Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m., Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon. For more information, call 745-0843.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Health investigators are racing to figure out how a nurse in Texas contracted Ebola, even though she used protective equipment when treating a Liberian who died of the disease in Dallas last week. The inquiry underscores the increased scrutiny hospital officials face over whether safety precautions taken by medical staff are sufficient. Nurse groups are demanding better training to avoid becoming infected with the deadly virus.

◆ American defense officials say Turkey will let U.S. and coalition forces use its bases for operations against Islamic State militants in Syria and Iraq. This includes a key installation within 100 miles of the Syrian border.

◆ In a dramatic shift in tone, a Vatican document, prepared after a week of discussions at an assembly of 200 bishops on the family, states that homosexuals have "gifts and qualities to offer" and asked if Catholicism could accept gays and recognize positive aspects of same-sex couples. The paper was hailed as a breakthrough by Roman Catholic gay rights groups around the world, but Church conservatives called it a betrayal of traditional family values.

◆ Taliban insurgents ambushed a convoy of Afghan security forces in a mountainous northern area on Monday. Twenty-two people were killed including police.

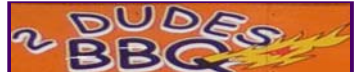

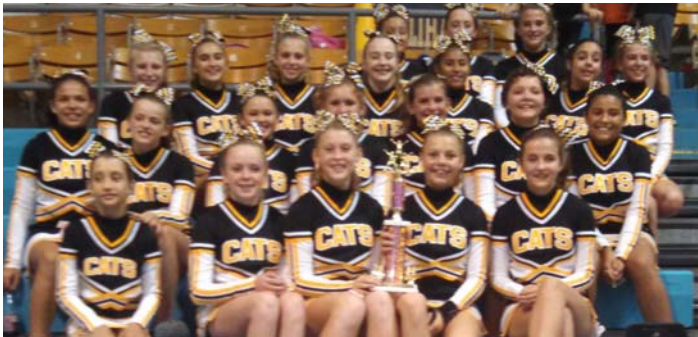
