### ◆ SHERIFF'S RACE IN MONROE CO. VOIDED

A lawsuit filed after the August election by former Monroe County Sheriff, Bill Bivens, was settled yesterday by Special Judge Don Ash, when he voided the election of Randy White to be the new sheriff. White won the election even though he was not certified by the Tennessee "Police Officers Standards & Training" Commission. When the P.O.S.T. commission gave its opinion, White's name was already on the ballot and early voting had begun. The judge's ruling means that Monroe County will either have to appoint someone to take White's place or order a new election to be held.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Republican lawmakers are pressing for a ban on travel to the U.S. from West African Ebola outbreak areas. As the pool of Americans being monitored expanded, the White House resisted the idea and tried to tamp down fear. In the meantime, the head of the International Red Cross is warning that the Ebola crisis will grow and that the threat of a "global health catastrophe" is real.

◆ On Thursday, a court convicted a Pakistani Christian man and sentenced him to death in a blasphemy case that sparked a riot last year in the eastern city of Lahore. The blasphemy law allows for punishment of life in prison or death and is often misused in Pakistan as a way to target people for personal gain or revenge.
