◆ VOTERS HAVE SPOKEN; NOW THE RESULTS

Voters in Athens have chosen three city council members to serve for the next four years. Incumbents Bo Perkinson and Dick Pelley were re-elected. Perkinson has served on the city council since 1996. Pelley has been on the council since 2002. The third seat goes to Yvonne Raper.

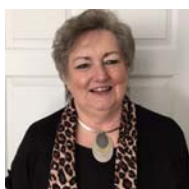
Congressman Chuck Fleischmann was re-elected to another term. Voters in both Athens (71%) and Etowah (57%) approved the referendum to allow grocery stores to sell wine. Athens voters approved a referendum to allow retail liquor stores by a large margin (64%). State Amendments in McMinn County: 1. (Abortion) Yes 66% 2. (Judges) Yes (68%) 3. (Income Tax) Yes (72%) 4. NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ A former Russian army officer facing terrorism charges for a 2009 attack on U.S. and Afghan forces made an initial appearance in federal court on Tuesday. Irek Ilgiz Hamidullin, is the first military detainee from Afghanistan to appear in a U.S. federal court. Hamidullin, was arrested in November 2009 and held in Afghanistan by the U.S. Department of Defense and was turned over to the Federal Bureau of Investigation on Monday.

◆ A federal judge ruled on Tuesday that a Kansas ban on same-sex marriage violates the U.S. Constitution and must be overturned. Judge Daniel Crabtree of the U.S. District Court granted a preliminary injunction on behalf of same-sex couples and put the ruling on hold until Nov. 11 to give Kansas an opportunity to appeal.
