### State and Local News

#### ◆ TWO YOUNG PEOPLE DIE ON I-75

Two young people, one from Athens, were killed in a two-vehicle traffic crash early Easter Sunday morning on Interstate 75 in Bradley County. The State Patrol says Thomas Dexter Toomey, 22, of Athens was traveling north on I-75 near mile marker 34 around 2:30 a.m. when he struck the rear of an SUV that was driving at a slower rate of speed in the left lane. State troopers say Toomey swerved in an attempt to miss the SUV, but clipped it. His vehicle then went out of control. It ran off the right side of the road, struck a tree, overturned, and then caught fire. His passenger, 23-year-old Katie Elizabeth Harris, of Montgomery, Alabama, was ejected, and the car landed on top of her. Troopers say neither was wearing a seat belt. Both Toomey and Ms. Harris were killed. There were six occupants in the SUV, all from Ohio. Four of them were children. None of them were injured.

- ◆ After 16 days of testimony from nearly 100 witnesses and several hours on Monday of closing arguments, jurors in Boston now have the case against the Boston Marathon bombing suspect. Jurors will first decide his guilt or innocence, not his punishment.
- ◆ Phi Kappa Psi fraternity says its plans to pursue legal action against *Rolling Stone Magazine* claiming "reckless reporting" of a University of Virginia rape story that was fabricated.
- ◆ A suspect in a Houston, Texas road rage shooting has reportedly been arrested. On March 20, the suspect shot Kay Hafford, 22, in the head after she honked at another driver for cutting her off. She is expected to make a full recovery.
