State & Local News

◆ HOUSE VOTES TO MAKE BIBLE STATE BOOK

The Tennessee House has passed a bill to make the Bible the official state book. The vote was 55 to 38. The measure was sponsored by Republican Rep. Jerry Sexton, a former pastor from Bean Station. The Senate has not yet voted on the bill.

- ✓ There will be no Heritage School this Saturday at the McMinn County Living Heritage Museum. The next session will be held on Saturday, April 25.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Hours after declaring Aaron Hernandez guilty of murder, all the jurors defended their decision in a rare post-verdict news conference. One juror said evidence that a gun linked to Hernandez had been found near the victim's body was "a shocker."
- ◆ Hundreds of Americans remain trapped in Yemen and escape routes are dwindling. In the past two weeks, 150 Americans have fled to Djibouti, and various boats have sailed and motored their way into the port. U.S. Ambassador, Tom Kelly encourages the trapped Americans to remain hopeful and to pursue all possible options out of Yemen.
- ◆ The pilot of a small helicopter that landed on the West Front lawn of the U.S. Capitol Building was arrested Wednesday, nearly a year and a half after his plot to land an aircraft near the Capitol or White House was investigated by the Secret Service.

ENGLEWOOD TO RECEIVE WATER LOAN

Englewood will receive \$775,000 for a Water Treatment Plant Improvements project which includes replacement of raw water pumps, filter improvements, electrical upgrades and other miscellaneous improvements. The project will be funded with a 20-year, \$542,500 loan, with an interest rate of 0.20%, and \$232,500 in principal forgiveness that will not have to be repaid. The announcement was made in Nashville yesterday.

WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks finished higher as positive earnings offset weaker-than-forecasted economic data. Volume on the New York Stock Exchange was moderate, with 872.80 million shares traded. Advancers outnumbered decliners by roughly a 2-to-1 margin.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 75.71 at 18,112.41. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 10.79 at 2,106.63, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 33.73 at 5,011.02.

1789 - President-elect George Washington left Mount Vernon, Virginia for his inauguration in New York.

1867 - Aviation pioneer Wilbur Wright was born. He and his brother, Orville, made the first airplane flight at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina.

1924 - Composer and orchestra leader Henry Mancini was born. His hits included "Moon River" and the "Pink Panther Theme."

1929 - Singers Roy Hamilton ("Unchained Melody") and Ed Townsend ("The End") were born.

1935 - Singer Bobby Vinton ("Roses Are Red") was born.
