## State and Local News

### ◆ TVA UNIT 2 REACTOR GETS A GREEN LIGHT

The Unit Two reactor at the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant is getting closer to producing electricity. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has voted to issue an operating license for the reactor, pending staff approval of final start-up tests. TVA expects to conduct those tests this summer, and hopes to begin generating power with the new reactor by the end of the year. Work on the Unit Two reactor began 36 years ago. If approved by the NRC staff, Watts Bar Unit Two will become the first commercial nuclear reactor in the U.S. to get an operating license since TVA completed the first reactor at Watts Bar in 1996.

### ◆ ALEXANDER WANTS ANSWERS ON ANTHRAX

Senator Lamar Alexander is demanding answers from the Defense Department after news that live anthrax bacteria was mistakenly shipped to labs in nine states, including Tennessee. The Department of Defense refuses to say which labs received the shipments, which were supposed to contain inactive anthrax spores. So far, no one has been sickened by the live anthrax, but several lab workers are being treated as a precaution. The anthrax was shipped from a Defense Department facility in Utah.

## THREE ARRESTED, DRUGS FOUND

The McMinn County Sheriff's Office has arrested three people and seized a large amount of cash, drugs, guns, and property. Sheriff Joe Guy says officers responded to a residence on County Road 162 on Wednesday after getting a call about people carrying guns and TV's into the house. Officers encountered three people and a search turned up the cash, drugs, and firearms. Officers found nearly \$5,000 in cash, crystal meth with a street value of \$5,000, several firearms, and a variety of surveying equipment and electronics that may be from area burglaries. The suspects were arrested on a variety of charges. They are identified as Jenny Burris, 23, of Sweetwater; Joel Lynn, 28, of Philadelphia; and Nicholas Robinette, 26, of Sweetwater. Charges included possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, possession of drugs, and possession of drug paraphernalia.
