## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ It may be premature to speculate on what appears to be a part of a Boeing 777 recovered on an island near Madagascar. Malaysia Airlines refers to the airplane component as a "flaperon", which is a wing segment that helps stabalize the plane. Experts are investigating whether the part could be connected to the Malaysia Air Flight 370 that disappeared in March, 2014.
- ◆ It was a rough afternoon for air travel at Dallas/Fort Worth Airport on Thursday as two separate planes were forced to evacuate in separate incidents. An American Airlines flight was forced to evacuate due to possible smoke in the cabin, and a Spirit Airlines flight experienced a fire in one of the landing gear tires and was forced to evacuate. All passengers departed safely, and there were no injuries.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks were little changed as investors weighed economic data and earnings. In economic news, the number of Americans filing new applications for unemployment benefits increased last week, but was still lower than expected.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 5.41 at 17,745.98. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 0.06 at 2,109.63, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 17.05 at 5,128.79.


