◆ A gunman unloaded his entire pistol into Harris County Sheriff's deputy Darren Goforth Saturday night. Deputy Goforth was fueling his patrol car at a gas station near Houston, Texas. Fifteen shell-casings were found at the scene. The shooter ran up behind Goforth and began firing immediately. The murder was caught on video.

◆ The name of North America's tallest mountain peak, Mount McKinley, will be changed to Denali by the Obama administration. This is a major symbolic gesture to Alaska Natives. Mount McKinley was named after the 25th president, William McKinley who was born in Ohio.

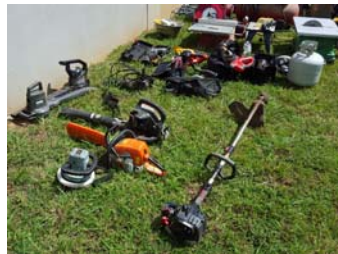
