State and Local News

◆ CALHOUN MAYOR FOUND NOT GUILTY

A McMinn County jury has found Calhoun Mayor John Walker not guilty of charges of burglary. The charges were related to items Walker had removed from an apartment that had been occupied by one of his tenants who had been served with an eviction notice. The tenant, in turn, had accused him of burglary. The jury found him not guilty.

◆ FORMER MAYOR BILL BRAKEBILL DIES

Former Athens Mayor William "Bill" Brakebill has died. Brakebill served on the Athens City Council from 1975 to 1991, and served as mayor from 1981 to 1983 and from 1985 until 1991. He was mayor in 1985 when President Ronald Reagan visited Athens. The photo to the right shows Mayor Brakebill presenting a saddle to President Reagan in front of the McMinn County Courthouse. The saddle was embossed with the words "Saddle up for tax reform." In addition to his service on the City Council, Brakebill was manager of Proffitt's Department Store in Athens from 1959 to 1986, and later worked in the insurance business. He was named Athens Man of the Year in 1982. He died on September 29th and was buried in Chattanooga National Cemetery.



NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Texas police officers in San Antonio found 39 illegal immigrants from Guatemala, El Salvador and Mexico, in the back of an 18-wheeler truck. The dramatic rescue was caught on body cameras worn by officers.

◆ Spencer Stone, one of the three Americans who helped stop a terrorist attack on a train this August in France is expected to make a full recovery after being stabbed outside a bar in California.

◆ Following nearly a week of violent shootings and stabbings in Jerusalem, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu advised citizens to be on "maximum alert" as the Israeli police beefed up security around the country.


- Boyd Memorial First Church of God will have revival services October 12th through 17th at 7 p.m. There will be special singing nightly. There will be different speakers each night.
