## NATIONAL AND WORLD NEWS

- ◆ A Periscope viewer helped a Florida police department identify and arrest an allegedly drunken-driver who was livestreaming from her car. Periscope is a live-streaming video service that allows app users to tune into anyone's live video based on location.
- ◆ A Ukrainian man who allegedly tried to frame cyber-security expert Brian Krebs has been extradited to the United States. Sergey Vovnenko is accused of taking part in an international conspiracy to hack into computer networks of individual users and corporations to steal log-in credentials and payment card data.
- ◆ Students at Umpqua Community College have gone back to school for the first time after a gunman opened fire nearly two weeks ago. Students were greeted with an emotional reception of hundreds gathered along a road leading up to the school to wave flags and show their support.
- ◆ A Taiwanese woman on board a Los Angeles-bound China Airlines flight unexpectedly gave birth to a bouncing baby girl last week after her water broke six hours into the 19-hour flight across the Pacific. Crew members and passengers, assisted a doctor who happened to be on board in delivering the baby girl at 30,000 feet.

### TODAY IN HISTORY-October 14

**1890** - Dwight David Eisenhower was born in Denison, Texas. He served as supreme commander of the Allied Forces in Europe during World War Two and later became the 34th President.

**1910** - Hall of Fame UCLA basketball coach John Wooden was born near Martinsville, Ind.

**1912** - Former President Theodore Roosevelt was shot in Milwaukee while campaigning for a third term. He refused to have the wound treated until he had finished his speech.

**1926** - *Winnie-the-Pooh*, made its debut on this day.

**1938** - Country singer Melba Montgomery ("No Charge") was born.

**1944** - German Field Marshal Erwin Rommel committed suicide rather than face execution for allegedly conspiring against Adolf Hitler.

**1947** - A plane flown by Chuck Yeager broke through the sound barrier for the first time.

**1961** - The Broadway production *How to Succeed in Business without Really Trying* opened on Broadway.

**1964** - Civil rights leader Martin Luther King Jr. was named winner of the Nobel Peace Prize. Dodger ace Sandy Koufax, working on just two days rest, pitched a three-hit shutout of the Minnesota Twins. Koufax struck out ten Twins on his way to the 2-0 win. And the Dodgers were World Series champs for the second time in three years.

**1968** - The first live telecast from a manned U.S. spacecraft was transmitted from Apollo 7.
