◆ NEW SENIOR LIVING CENTER PLANNED

Construction is scheduled to begin soon on a 50,000 square-foot, \$8 million, faith-based assisted living and memory care senior living community in Athens. Dominion Senior Living of Athens will be located at 2090 W. Madison Avenue and will have 42 assisted living and 18 memory care apartments. The facility is being built by Knoxville-based Dominion Senior Living. The company's Vice President is Josh Crisp, who was raised in Athens and is the son of Dr. Tony Crisp, pastor of Eastanallee Baptist Church in Riceville. 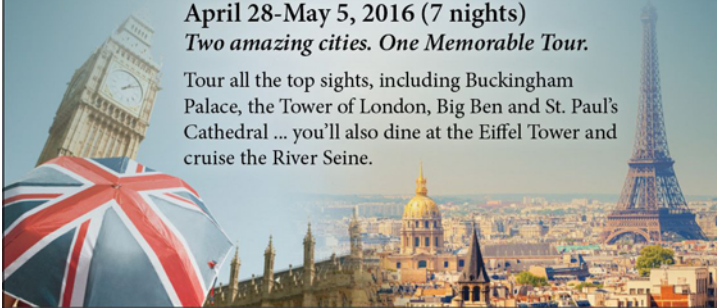
