◆ VETERANS PARADE IS SATURDAY

The annual Veterans Parade will take place this Saturday in Downtown Athens at 3 p.m. The parade forms in the Courthouse Annex parking lot. The parade will go along W. Madison Avenue to the Courthouse, then north on White Street to College Street, and then south on Jackson Street ending at Market Park. There will be a brief ceremony at the Market Park Pavilion, followed by free hamburgers. The public is invited to attend and show support for our veterans. The parade is sponsored by the Elks Lodge. Streets in Downtown Athens will be closed from 2:30 p.m. until 6 p.m.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ British and U.S. officials claim they have information suggesting the Russian jetliner that crashed in the Egyptian desert may have been brought down by a bomb. Britain is suspending flights to and from the Sinai Peninsula indefinitely.

◆ A northern Illinois policeman, Lieutenant Charles Joseph Gliniewicz, whose September death prompted an extensive man-hunt for murder suspects actually committed "a carefully staged suicide." Earlier, authorities had begun an audit that would have exposed his embezzling public funds for personal purchases, stealing and laundering money over the past seven years, and forging signatures on documents.

◆ Adacia Chambers, the 25-year-old woman from Stillwater, Oklahoma, was formally charged Wednesday with four counts of second-degree murder and 46 counts of felony assault. Chambers is accused of running a red light and purposely driving around a barricade and over a police motorcycle and crashing into spectators at Oklahoma State University's homecoming parade.
