### ◆ KEEPING OUR CHURCHES SAFE

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy is offering to advise churches on how they can improve security. Sheriff Guy says arming church staff is one option, but he says there are many "soft" security practices not involving firearms that can also help keep a church location safe and reduce the chances of a critical incident. The sheriff says it's not about discouraging staff members from carrying guns. He says he and his deputies want to lay out the pros and cons of both sides, let church leaders know there are options, and then let them decide what they want to do. He says the deputies will talk to churches about their worship times, whether they lock their perimeter doors during their worship service, and whether they have greeters who engage people as they come in.
