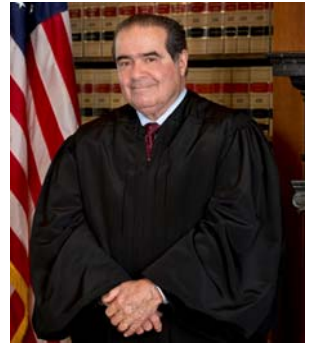
#### ◆ ONE DEAD, TWO HURT IN STARR MT. CRASH

An Etowah man was killed and two people were injured when their jeep slid off an icy road on Starr Mountain in Polk County last Friday. Authorities say the jeep made it to the top, but slid out of control on an icy spot on the way down, went over an embankment, and landed 200 feet below at the bottom of a ravine. All three occupants were thrown out. The driver, 45-year-old Charlie Phillip Green of Etowah, died, another man suffered serious head injuries, and a female suffered cuts and bruises. ◆ U.S. Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia died Saturday at the age of 79. The judicial standard-bearer of the conservative movement was discovered dead when he failed to appear for breakfast at a private residence in Texas where he was on a hunting trip. President Obama says he will nominate a replacement, setting up a Senate battle in the heat of an election year.
