Local & State News

◆ EARLY MORNING FIRE IN CHARLESTON

A fire early Monday morning at a Lonza warehouse in Charleston was quickly extinguished by Lonza's Emergency Response Team. The fire was reported at 7:40 a.m. and was out by 8 a.m. One employee was treated on site for chlorine inhalation and was sent home for the day. Employees were under a "shelter in place" warning for about 90 minutes until the facility was declared safe. Students at Walker Valley High School and Charleston Elementary School also sheltered in place as a precautionary measure. Lonza, along with outside officials, will now investigate the cause of the fire.

◆ CONG. DUNCAN ENDORSES TRUMP

Third District Congressman Jimmy Duncan has endorsed Donald Trump for the Republican presidential nomination. Duncan cites Trump's ability to leverage trade, his stance on enforcing immigration laws, and his ability to rebuild the country. Trump responded to the endorsement by describing Duncan as one of the most fiscally conservative members of the House. He said if more members voted like Duncan, the U.S. would not be wasting trillions of the taxpayer dollars in foreign countries. Senator Bob Corker says he will not be endorsing any candidate.

NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

◆ Puerto Rico's government failed to make a large debt payment of nearly \$370 million in bond payments on Monday. The default could intensify the island's financial crisis.

◆ The Supreme Court will not take up a challenge to Seattle's minimum wage increase. The lower court upheld a Seattle law that requires businesses with five hundred or more employees to raise their minimum wage to \$15 per hour by 2018.

◆ Wall Street closed higher for the first trading day of May, stopping a seven-day slump. The Dow was up 117.52 to close at 17,891.16. The Nasdaq was up 42.24 to close at 4,817.59, and the S&P was up 16.13 to close at 2,081.43. Crude oil tumbled over 2 percent with prices hitting about \$44 a barrel.
