◆ FORMER UT VOL FILES LAWSUIT

Former University of Tennessee football player Orenthal James Owens has filed a lawsuit against the Southeastern Conference and the NCAA. The lawsuit says Owens is suffering long-lasting effects of a concussion that occurred while he was playing at UT. Owens was a member of the Vols from 2000 to 2003, and suffered multiple injuries. In the lawsuit, he claims the SEC and the NCAA knew of possible brain injuries from playing football, but concealed the information in order to make money.

NATIONAL - WORLD NEWS

◆ Dealing a blow to gun supporters, a federal appeals court in San Francisco ruled Thursday that Americans do not have a constitutional right to carry concealed weapons in public. By a vote of 7-4, the court upheld a California law that says applicants must cite a "good cause" to obtain a concealed-carry permit. Circuit Judge William A. Fletcher wrote for the majority, that the Second Amendment does not preserve or protect a right of a member of the general public to carry concealed firearms in public.

◆ Republican Governor John Kasich signed a bill Wednesday legalizing medical marijuana in Ohio. The bill lays out a number of steps that must happen first to set up the state's medical marijuana program, which should take about two years. The law would allow patients to use marijuana in vapor form for certain chronic health conditions, but bar them from smoking it or growing it at home.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks dropped amid a pullback in oil prices.

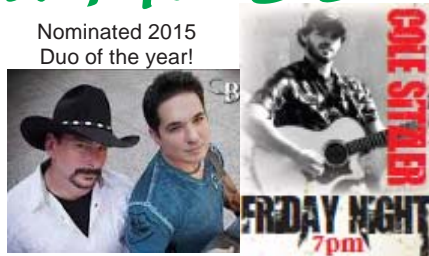
