NATIONAL - WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Senate Democrats ended a nearly 15-hour filibuster early Thursday after Republican Party leaders agreed to allow votes on two proposed gun control measures.
- ◆ The cockpit voice recorder from the crashed EgyptAir Flight 804 has been found in the Mediterranean Sea.
- ◆ According to the CDC, at least 234 pregnant women in the U.S. and the District of Columbia are infected with the Zika virus, and another 198 pregnant women in the U.S. territories have tested positive for Zika.
- ◆ The owner of a Florida gun store said the Orlando nightclub shooter tried to buy body armor and bulk ammunition from his store just a few weeks before the shooting. The FBI is aware of and is investigating his visit to the gun store.
- ◆ Sen. John McCain, said Thursday that President Obama was "directly responsible" for the Orlando attack, a comment he later clarified as a criticism of the president's national security policies. McCain stated that "President Obama's decision to completely withdraw U.S. troops from Iraq in 2011 led to the rise of ISIL."
