

Local and Area News

◆ IT'S SOAPBOX DERBY WEEK ONCE AGAIN!

The 79th running of the FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby will be held this week through Saturday, July 16th. It takes place at the world famous Derby Downs Track in Akron, Ohio. The City of

◆ GOOD NEWS FOR MOTORISTS--SORT OF

A spokesman at the Tennessee Department of Transportation tells the MORNING FAX that Ingleside Avenue will be resurfaced, sometime. Once a contract has been awarded, the successful bidder has the option of performing the work within the current paving season or they could wait until next spring. Meanwhile, resurfacing Highway 305 between Congress Parkway and I-75 won't fix the problems there. TDOT says the subgrade will have to be repaired which will require a major construction project.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Thousands of demonstrators flooded the streets of major U.S. cities over the weekend, protesting the recent killings by police of black men in suburban St. Paul, Minnesota and in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. A demonstration in St. Paul took a very violent turn, with participants hurling Molotov cocktails, fireworks, rocks, glass bottles, concrete slabs, and bricks at riot gear-wearing police officers. Over 200 arrests were made in both cities.
- ◆ Meanwhile, in Dallas, Texas, police officials say that the sniper that shot 12 of their police officers, and killing five of them, was killed after barricading himself inside a building. The shooter told hostage negotiators he was angry about recent shootings of black men by police and that he wanted to kill white people, especially police officers. After the hours-long standoff with law enforcement, the shooter was killed by officers who detonated a bomb delivered by a robot, which appears to be the first time this tactic was used by civilian police in the U.S.
- ◆ Russia has expelled two American diplomats after the United States kicked out two Russian embassy staff to protest an incident in which a Russian police guard apparently tackled a U.S. diplomat outside its embassy in Moscow.
- ◆ The Democratic Party is on track to ratify what is arguably its most liberal/progressive policy agenda in modern history, after the committee tasked with writing the platform document finished its final round of amendments and votes over the weekend.
- ◆ A Delta Airlines flight from Atlanta to Denver was diverted to Tulsa after multiple passengers reported feeling ill simultaneously
