◆ SCHOOL OFFICIALS TO REVIEW DRESS CODE

McMinn County school officials say they will take another look at the dress code which does not allow students to wear shirts with logos larger than a credit card. Kelsi Moore, a student at McMinn High School, went to school last week wearing a shirt with the Marine Corps logo on it. The shirt had USMC in large letters on it. Kelsi is the daughter of a Marine, was in Junior ROTC at Bearden High School in Knoxville during her freshman and sophomore years, and wore 2nd Battalion Marine Corps Division shirts to support her dad and the military. Now that she's a student at McMinn High, she can no longer wear the shirt. She was called into the office last week and told her shirt violated the school dress code. She was given the option of turning the shirt inside out or changing shirts. She called her mother to bring her another shirt. After school, she and her family went to the Board of Education. The board was sympathetic, and asked Kelsi to join the dress code committee. They say they will review the dress code.

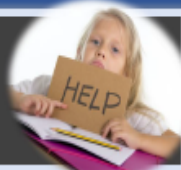
