MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks closed lower Monday as oil prices declined, and investors weighed earnings reports.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 51.98 at 18,086.40. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 6.48 at 2,126.50, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 14.34 at 5,199.82.

In commodity markets, the spot price of gold rose \$3.57 to \$1,254.99. The spot price of silver rose \$0.03 to \$17.45, and crude oil prices fell \$0.45 to \$49.90.

In bond markets, the 30-year Treasury yield closed at 2.52%, and the 10-year Treasury yield finished at 1.77%.
