◆ DROUGHT LEADS TO FIRE RESTRICTIONS

U.S. Forest Service Officials at the Cherokee National Forest have implemented special fire restrictions due to the extremely dry conditions, high fire danger and little chance of rain in the immediate future. No fires will be allowed in the forest unless it is in a developed recreation area where metal fire rings and grills are provided. Portable lanterns, stoves or heating equipment that utilize gas or pressurized liquid fuel will be allowed. Meanwhile, a large fire near Parksville Lake in Polk County has burned several hundred acres. (see photos) Englewood City and Rural Fire Department Chief Billy Roach tells the MORNING FAX that over a dozen brush fires occurred in McMinn County over the weekend. The Tenn. 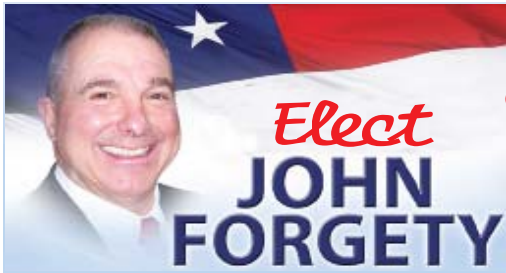

IT'S TRICK OR TREAT TIME

- The Athens Fire Department has some Halloween safety tips:
1. If your child is wearing a mask, make sure the eye holes are large enough for them to see out clearly.
 2. It is safer to use a flashlight or battery-operated candles in a Jack-o-lantern. If you do use a real candle, place the lit pumpkins well away from anything that can burn.
 3. Children should always go trick-or-treating with a responsible adult.
 4. Children should stay together as a group when walking house-to-house.
 5. Review how to cross a street, reminding your child to look left, right, and left again to be sure no cars are coming.
 6. Check your child's treats before allowing them to be eaten.
