He represents the Second District, which included McMinn County for many years until lines were re-drawn and McMinn moved to the Third District.

National & World News

- ◆ Christopher Wray was confirmed by the senate 92-5 on Tuesday as the new director of the FBI, almost three months after his predecessor, James Comey, was fired.
- ◆ The U.S. Navy is conducting a search and rescue mission for a sailor who went missing from the USS Stethem. The ship was conducting routine operations in the South China Sea on Tuesday. This rescue effort represents the second major search of its kind in the Asia-Pacific region this summer. The first search and rescue effort took place in June near Okinawa, Japan, and ended after 50 hours when the missing sailor was found hiding in the engineering spaces of his ship.
