♦ NEW EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

McMinn County has launched an enhanced version of its Emergency Preparedness and Mass Notification services for citizens:

tn-mcminncounty.regroup.com. This mass communication tool allows local government to communicate with citizens quickly and efficiently before, during, and after an emergency. In addition, it can be used for routine events and community updates. Citizens can be reached through e-mail, SMS, voice calls, and social media platforms depending on preference. Tom Trotter, the Director of McMinn County Emergency Management, says McMinn County's emergency notification system will alert residents about a variety of events, ranging from severe weather, fires, hazardous materials, and floods. To sign up, go to mcminncountytn.gov and navigate to the Emergency Management page under the County Offices pull down tab. Then, click on the Sign Up for Emergency Alerts link.



BACK TO SCHOOL SAFETY

The Athens Police Department has issued some safety tips for the beginning of the school year. Among them:

- Always stop at crosswalks
- Always stop for school buses loading and unloading.
- Avoid using a cell phone, unless it is hands-free, while driving in a school zone.

- If walking to school, children should always use public sidewalks, walk with other children, and go straight home after school.
- If riding a school bus, do not shout or distract the driver.

TODAY IN HISTORY - AUGUST 9TH

1854 - Henry David Thoreau published "Walden," which described his experiences living near Walden Pond in Massachusetts.

1945 - The United States exploded a nuclear device over Nagasaki, Japan, instantly killing an estimated 39,000 people. The bombing came three days after Hiroshima was bombed.

1963 - Singer Whitney Houston was born. Her biggest hit records include "The Greatest Love Of All" and "I Will Always Love You."

1969 - Actress Sharon Tate and four other people were found murdered in Los Angeles. Cult leader Charles Manson and a group of his followers were later convicted of the crime.

1974 - President Richard Nixon's resignation became effective at noon, and Vice President Gerald Ford was sworn in as the nation's 38th President.
