### ◆ CITY COUNCIL TO REVIEW BEER SALES

The Athens City Council will be considering whether to allow outdoor beer sales during such events as Pumpkintown and Sounds of Summer. Tim Hughes and Meredith Willson appeared at the council's study session earlier this week to ask the council to allow the sale of beer. They say beer sales would attract a different crowd, including a lot of young people. Hughes said the Pumpkintown Festival in October could serve as a "trial." He proposed using the parking lot at what used to be Burkett's BBQ restaurant as a beer garden where people would be allowed to drink. There would be one way in and out with a police officer stationed there. The council directed City Manager C. Seth Sumner to draft an ordinance to allow the sale of beer in time for it to be reviewed at the September study session.
