◆ UNEMPLOYMENT DOWN IN ALL COUNTIES

The unemployment rate in all 95 counties in Tennessee decreased in August. In McMinn County, the jobless rate in August was 4.1%, down from 4.6% in July. Meigs County's unemployment rate in August was 4.9%, down from 5.6% in July. In Monroe County, the unemployment rate in August dropped to 3.9%, down from 4.5% in July. Polk County recorded a jobless rate of 4.2% in August, and Bradley County's unemployment rate was 3.5% in August. Rhea County had the highest unemployment rate in Tennessee in August at 6.0%.

- ◆ For the first time in its nearly 250-year history, the U.S. Marine Corps has a female infantry officer who graduated on Monday from the Marines' Infantry Officer Course in Quantico, Virginia. She is now a lieutenant and wishes to keep her identity private. She is the first woman to finish the challenging course and the fourth to attempt it since the Marines opened all military occupational specialties, known as MOS, to women in April 2016.
- ◆ Anthony Weiner, the disgraced former New York congressman and soon-to-be ex-husband of top Hillary Clinton aide Huma Abedin, broke down in federal court Monday. He was sentenced to 21 months in prison for sending obscene material to a 15-yearold high school student in North Carolina.


